HUMAN BLOOD/BLOOD PRODUCTS, TISSUES AND OTHER BODILY FLUIDS THAT MAY CONTAIN OR ARE ISOLATES OF ACINETOBACTER BAUMANNII, ACHROMOBACTER XYLOSOXIDANS, HUMAN IMMUNODEFICIENCY VIRUS, HEPATITIS VIRUS (A, B, C, D, AND E), ACINETOBACTER CALCOACETICUS, ACTINOMYCES ISRAELII, AEROMONAS HYDROPHILA, ALCALIGENES FAECALIS, ASPERGILLUS FUMIGATUS, BACTEROIDES SPECIES, BURKHOLDERIA SPECIES (EXCLUDING SELECT AGENTS), CAMPYLOBACTER SPECIES, CANDIDA SPECIES, CITROBACTER FREUNDII, CLOSTRIDIUM SPECIES (EXCLUDING SELECT AGENTS), CORYNEBACTERIUM KUTSCHERI, CRYPTOCOCCUS SPECIES, EDWARDSIELLA TARDA, ENTEROBACTER SAKAZAKII, ENTEROCOCCUS SPECIES, EPIDERMOPHYTON FLOCCOSUM, ESCHERICHIA COLI, EUBACTERIUM LENTUM, FUSOBACTERIUM NUCLEATUM, GARDNERELLA VAGINALIS, GEOTRICHUM CANDIDUM, HAEMOPHILUS SPECIES, HELICOBACTER PYLORI, KLEBSIELLA PNEUMONIA, LACTOBACILLUS ACIDOPHILUS, MICROSPORUM SPECIES, MORAXELLA CATARRHALIS, NEISSERIA GONORRHOEAE, PEPTOSTREPTOCOCCUS ANAEROBIUS, PROPIONIBACTERIUM ACNES, PROTEUS VULGARIS, PSEUDOMONAS SPECIES, RHODOTORULA RUBRA, SALMONELLA SPECIES, SERRATIA MARCESCENS, SHIGELLA SPECIES, SPHINGOMONAS PAUCIMOBILIS, SPOROTHRIX SCHENCKII, STAPHYLOCOCCUS SPECIES, STENOTROPHOMONAS MALTOPHILIA, STREPTOCOCCUS SPECIES, TRICHOPHYTON SPECIES, VIBRIO SPECIES OR YERSINIA ENTEROCOLITICA.

5. CONDITIONS OF ISSUANCE ITEMS APPLICABLE WHEN CHECKED

PACKAGING MUST CONFORM TO 49 CFR SECTIONS 171-180.

WORK WITH THE AGENT(S) DESCRIBED SHALL BE RESTRICTED TO AREAS AND CONDITIONS MEETING REQUIREMENTS IN THE CDC/NIH PUBLICATION "BIOSAFETY IN MICROBIOLOGICAL AND BIOMEDICAL LABORATORIES.

AS THE PERMITTEE, YOUR FACILITY WILL BE SUBJECT TO INSPECTION AT SOME TIME IN THE FUTURE TO CONFIRM THAT THE IMPORTERS BIOSAFETY MEASURES ARE COMMENSURATE WITH THE HAZARD POSED BY THE ITEMS TO BE IMPORTED AND THE LEVEL OF RISK GIVEN ITS INTENDED USE.

ALL MATERIAL IS FOR LABORATORY USE ONLY - NOT FOR USE IN THE PRODUCTION OF BIOLOGICS FOR HUMANS OR ANIMALS.

APHIS OR CDC MUST BE NOTIFIED (IMMEDIATELY FOR A TIER 1 SELECT AGENT AND WITHIN 7 DAYS FOR A NON-TIER 1 SELECT AGENT) BY THE PERMITTEE OF THE

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IDENTIFICATION OF A SELECT AGENT OR TOXIN IN MATERIAL SUBJECT TO THIS PERMIT. FAILURE TO REPORT THE IDENTIFICATION OF A SELECT AGENT OR TOXIN IN MATERIAL SUBJECT TO THIS PERMIT MAY RESULT IN THE REVOCATION OF THIS PERMIT AND/OR THE IMPOSITION OF CRIMINAL AND/OR CIVIL PENALTIES.

THE SUBSEQUENT DISTRIBUTION OF SARS-COV-2 WILL REQUIRE AN ADDITIONAL SEPARATE PERMIT.
